

Wisdom [is] the broadest, most inclusive term available to depict the combination of observation, obedience, careful planning, prudent conduct, and sensitivity to God's will that Israel's wise treasured and taught."





<sup>1</sup>For I want you to know how great a struggle I have for you and for those at Laodicea and for all who have not seen me face to face, 2that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ,


and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 1 Corinthians 1:20-25






"Be wise, my son, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him who reproaches me.






<sup>25</sup>A foolish son is a grief to his father and bitterness to her who bore him.

<sup>5</sup>And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." 'It is for discipline that you have to endure.



God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? <sup>8</sup>If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them.



Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live? 'For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness. "For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant,



but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.




<sup>24</sup>Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him.

<sup>18</sup>Discipline your son, for there is hope; do not set your heart on putting him to death.




